Pre-Construction Activity Begins on EcoGrove Wind Energy Facility

FREEPORT, Ill. – May 30, 2008 – Preliminary construction work has begun on the EcoGrove wind energy facility in Stephenson County.

EcoEnergy is working with Kent Family Farms, a landowner participant in the EcoGrove project, to prepare a “lay-down area” for storage of cable and equipment during construction. The company also is working with Kent Family Farms to secure an indoor storage area for its equipment.

The first phase of the facility’s construction will include more than 60 turbines for a total of 100 megawatts (MW).

“This is a very exciting time for all of us at EcoEnergy, because we’re bringing clean, green wind power ‘home’ to where our parent company got its start,” said Nick Rigas, EcoEnergy senior developer of wind energy. “We look forward to continuing the Morse Group tradition of building good relationships in the communities we serve.”
